There are various types of resources we may wish to share with students – book chapters, journal articles, film clips etc.

Sharing of information with students is often via Moodle, and this is governed by the Copyright Licensing Agency (CLA). It's important to know what's allowed.







SHORT QUOTES & EXTRACTS - ALL TYPES OF COPYRIGHT WORKS e.g. text, illustrations

	Materials are only used to illustrate or reinforce a teaching point	Materials are only available for students on the course	
	Only selected content is copied and displayed	Original sources are cited (unless impractical)	




JOURNAL ARTICLES & BOOK CHAPTERS

According to the University CLA HE Licence:

	Photocopied materials can only be shared with students enrolled on that course	Digital copies of material can only be shared with students enrolled on that course	
	PDFs must be accessed from source files – only links should be provided in Moodle	Only students enrolled on a course should be given access to the course Moodle site
