Terms of reference – Teaching Committee (undergraduate)

Teaching Committee

- 1. To monitor the planning (including assignment of specific teaching tasks to individuals), administration (including budgeting) and continuity of all undergraduate courses (including Part III) with which the Department is formally involved (including receiving data on the admissions into those courses), to ensure the appropriate development of those courses in line with overall learning and teaching objectives, and to facilitate the dissemination of good practice.
- 2. To receive comments and recommendations from the Teaching Executive Committee, and to delegate implementation of decisions to the TEC as appropriate.
- 3. Where appropriate, to set up working groups to consider the longer term needs of individual courses, as well as the Department's undergraduate Learning and Teaching provision overall.
- 4. To receive and act on as necessary the results of student feedback on courses, by receipt of course questionnaires and/or questionnaire summaries, by receipt of minutes of course consultative and management committees, and by comment from course organisers and others.
- 5. To agree, subject to the concurrence of the TEC and HoD, the appointment of examiners, with external examiners being invited through the HoD's office.
- 6. To receive, discuss and act on as necessary reports from Examiners, and to assist the HoD and Director of Teaching in drawing up responses to External Examiners.
- 7. To monitor developments in Learning and Teaching provision across the University including, but not limited to, the proceedings of the Biological Sciences and NST Management Committees.
- 8. To submit Minutes to the Staff Meeting, Academic and Management Committees of the Department.
